

Organisation and protocol opening the pool

At the beginning of the course until further notice the school pool will be closed, before the opening of the pool during the 2020-21 school year, it will take into account the protocols according to current regulations and determined by the competent authorities. As well as the measures and regulations established at the time by the Ministry of Health, to maintain an adequate level of hygiene in the facilities and a correct treatment of the water to ensure that the pool is a safe place. On opening the pool the following basic measures will be applied:

- Compliance with current national, regional or local regulations regarding these facilities.
- Observe the social distance measures and the rest of the recommended measures.
- The necessary gauging and access control measures will be put in place, respecting the minimum recommended preventive distances.
- The minimum capacities established by current regulations will be established.
- Hydroalcoholic gel will be put at the entrance to the facility.
- Incorporation of specific footwear for use in the pool area.
- Poster with prevention messages to remind of good practices.
- Swimsuits, towels and pool equipment must be washed after use.
- All students will shower before entering the pool
- All pool staff will reinforce their hand hygiene by frequent washing with soap and water and the use of hydroalcoholic gels.
- Closed spaces will be ventilated frequently.
- Exhaustive cleaning and disinfection of the areas a minimum of two times a day, with special emphasis on the most frequented areas, locker rooms, toilets, inside lockers, showers and toilets. Using virucidal disinfectants for this.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the furniture used after each use.
