

Procedure for cleaning and disinfection of classroom

Each classroom will have:

- Hydroalcoholic gel.
- Paper towels.
- Students cannot bring personal material to the school; they will only bring their appropriate school material for the day's lessons. Nor can material from the school can be brought to the student's home, except in cases where the teacher determines.
- The School cleaning teams will clean every classroom and the material used daily.
- Tablets, laptops, and computer mice should not be shared, and should be cleaned before and after each use.
- As long as the weather permits, the doors will be kept open to avoid contact with door knobs.
- As long as the weather permits, the windows will be kept open. In any case, the classrooms will be ventilated several times each day.
- Textiles. Textiles will be removed preventively from classrooms (rugs, cushions, etc ...)
- The textiles with a cover will be washed daily at +60 or a disposable cover used.
- Games or materials that are difficult to keep perfectly sanitized will be temporarily removed.
- The presence of unnecessary elements of furniture in the classrooms will be reduced to facilitate the highest degree of hygiene in the environment of the students.
- An enclosed "dirty area" will be created in the area of Early Childhood Education and the first years of Primary School, to deposit the games or materials used during the day so that the cleaning team can disinfect them correctly. Whenever possible, this area will be located outside the classrooms and away from students.
