

Novaschool Nursery Schools from 0 to 3 years

Within the Covid19 Action Plan, implementing in all the group's educational centres Novaschool includes a series of measures that apply to students and families of Infant Schools from 0 to 3 years:

- Access to nursery school: upon arrival at the centre, students will be received by educational personnel at the school's assigned entrance, so the Family members will not access the interior of the educational centre. The students will be accompanied to their coexistence classroom (groups will be held by courses) and following the specific instructions of the nursery school.
- At the entrance to the centre, students must step with their shoes on the carpet impregnated with virucidal disinfectant.
- Backpacks will not be used, and it is recommended to use duffel bags. where the student brings to school their belongings for daily use: water, breakfast / snack. The rest of the belongings will be in the centre. With that we want to avoid objects that enter and leave the school daily.
- School agenda: this year we will use the school agenda through the APP myAgora + from Novaschool and we eliminated the paper agenda.
- During the afternoons, students who remain after 15 hours in the centre will be with the groups of coexistence by course for the realization of workshops and snacks.
- The morning classroom will be held in classrooms with enough space and / or patio always weather permitting, to maintain safety distances between coexistence groups.
- If a student arrives outside of the opening hours, she must enter through the door centre and contact the centre's Secretariat so that it can be attended and be accompanied to class.
- The same guidelines will be followed when picking up students upon departure. The Students' families will not be able to access the centre and the exit will also be done in a staggered manner.
- No minor may attend the educational centre if they have had a fever (Body temperature above 37.5°C) in the last 24 hours or in the case of that a family member you live with has symptoms such as fever, cough or feeling short of breath (common symptoms of Covid-19).

- The cleaning teams of the centre will clean each classroom and the material on a daily basis, used as indicated in the general protocols.
- Diaper changes and whenever the students allow it, they are They will perform standing up to avoid sharing changing tables.
- When the changing table is used, between diaper changes, the changing table and the teachers will do hand washing.
- Preventively, textiles will be removed from the classrooms (carpets, cushions, etc.)
- Games or materials that are difficult to maintain will be temporarily withdrawn perfectly sanitised.
- The presence of unnecessary elements of furniture in classrooms will be reduced to facilitate the highest degree of hygiene in the students' environment. A “dirty area” will be delimited in the classrooms, to deposit at the end of the day the games or materials used during the day and that the cleaning crew can disinfect them properly.
- Staggered recess schedules will be created differentiated by stages to offer all students the opportunity to go outside.
- All equipment and / or furniture in the outdoor play areas will be cleaned background before and after each recess and between the 1-year and 2-year shift.
- Naps will be done in sleep classrooms and classrooms to ensure that there are distances between beds.
- During naps, cribs or beds (with bedding) will also be assigned to each one of the students for personal use.
- Bedding will be changed at least once a week and must be washed at + 60°.
- Meals will be made in most cases in their classroom, being groups specific those who will go to the dining room.
- The necessary tutorials or administrative procedures will be carried out whenever is viable in the online mode. Given the impossibility of doing it online, will manage in person always by appointment.
- The secretaries' schedule has been adapted to the new situation and it is not possible to be consistent with the opening hours with the entry and exit times from school.
